Link thumbs and flap around

Day Six: ANIMALS

*Scratch head with one hand and under armpit
with the other. (Works for either creature...)*

Day Seven: THE SABBATH

(whispered and a little tired):

In the beginning, when God began to play,
the world was created on the seventh day.
"Just move on over, Give me some space,
I'm setting out my lawn chair to quiet down the
place,"
says God. *Open lawn chair*
